

#### VALUATION

The determination of value under any provisions of the Rio Vista Building Code shall be made by the Building Official based on available printed information. This valuation shall include the total value of all construction work for which the permit is issued as well as all finish work, painting, roofing, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, heating, air conditioning, elevators, fire extinguishing systems, and any other permanently installed equipment. For industrial facilities, the value of process equipment and heavy machinery supported by the structure or by its own foundation shall be included. Contractor overhead and profit shall be included.

The valuation of grading, retaining walls, paving and other site work, and any demolition work, shall be included unless such work was was included in other permits.

The valuation data is used to establish consistent criteria for calculating permit fees, and the calculated total valuation does not necessarily necessarily reflect actual costs. The County Assessor does not rely on these costs, but performs independent assessments of the permitted work.
