
**MTC 2006 TRANSIT PASSENGER DEMOGRAPHICS SURVEY
BENICIA BREEZE AND RIO VISTA TRANSIT**

Methodology Overview

The study was conducted on Benicia Breeze Transit (hereinafter: Breeze) from February 7, 2007 to February 21, 2007, and on Rio Vista Transit (hereinafter: Rio) on February 20, 2007. Routes included were 19, 21, 22, 23, and 75 (see Tables i and ii, below). A full explanation of the methodology used for the overall study can be found in Appendix A. For Benicia Breeze, a total of 150 interviews were completed, 112 during the weekdays and 38 over the weekend. Comparisons to the "All Systems" refer to the total overall MTC study for all 22 transit systems, and have been tested to a confidence level of 95 percent.

For Breeze and Rio, there was one interviewer assigned to each route. There were two shifts of interviews, 6 AM to 1 PM and 1 PM to 9 PM to cover both peak and off-peak hours for each shift. For the Breeze sampling plan, the total number of interviews to be conducted was divided amongst routes running on the weekends and those running on weekdays in proportion to the average ridership of weekdays and weekends. Weekday routes and weekend routes were then sampled based on the proportion of the total ridership for each route. Percentages of riders shown for each provider are for an entire weekday or weekend and are the percentage of riders amongst all routes.

The interviews to be conducted on each route were chosen in proportion to the ridership of each route; except for those routes with ridership proportions under 10%, where a random number generator was used to assign coverage. Sampled routes were then checked to ensure a disproportionate geographic representation did not exist.

Interviewer start time was when randomly selected bus, train or ferry that left in the first hour of their shift. For example, if a route has a bus that left the first stop at 6:00 AM, another leaving at 6:20 AM, and a third leaving at 6:40 AM, the interviewer had one of those three randomly selected as the beginning of his/her shift.

For the Rio sampling plan, a census approach was taken, where all riders on all routes were surveyed. For this reason, no sampling plan was developed.

Findings

Breeze (48.7%) respondents were most likely to indicate that “Home” was their point of origin, followed by “Work” (24.0%) and “Shopping” (9.3%). Breeze results for “Shopping” are significantly higher than those returned for All Systems (4.2%).

* The “All Systems” column contains the combined results of all 22 transit systems included in the survey. The data shown are weighted to the actual proportions of ridership for each transit system in the region. See Appendix A for more details of the study methodology.

The most common destination for Breeze respondents was “Home,” followed by “Work” and “School or College” (with 40.7%, 33.3%, and 10.7%, respectively). All these results are statistically identical to those returned for All Systems

The most common trip times for Breeze respondents were 30-39 minutes, 20-29 minutes, and 40-49 minutes (with 18.0%, 15.3%, and 14.0%, respectively). All of these results are statistically equal to the All Systems results for these time brackets.

Breeze respondents were most likely to indicate that they made their trip 4-5 days a week, 1-3 days a week, or 6-7 days a week (48.7%, 23.3%, and 17.3% respectively). These results are statistically identical to the All Systems results returned for these brackets.

Breeze respondents were most likely to pay their fare with “cash” (70%), or a “pass” (23.3%). Breeze results are significantly higher than All Systems results for “cash” (52.6%). Breeze “pass” results are significantly lower than the All Systems (30.8%).

The most common fare category for Breeze respondents was “Adult” (75.3%), followed by “Youth or Student” (14.0%). These results are statistically equal to the All Systems results.

About four in ten (40.7%) Breeze respondents indicated that they took public transit because a car was not available to them. Within this group, 72.1% of respondents indicated that they did not regularly have a car available to them. This means that 29% of Breeze respondents are transit-dependent. This is statistically equal to the 23% all systems result. Of those who did not have a car available but normally do, 64.7% indicate that having a car available does not present an inconvenience for others.

Breeze respondents were most likely to indicate that they were 18 to 24 (26.0%), 45 to 54 (21.3%), or 25 to 34 (17.3%). Breeze respondents were more likely than All Systems respondents to identify as 45 to 54 (12.8%). Breeze respondents were significantly less likely to identify as 25 to 34 than All Systems respondents (26.3%).

Most (83.3%) Breeze respondents indicate that they do not have transit-dependent children under 13 living at home; while 11.6% indicated they had one and 2.9% indicated they had two. All of these results are statistically equal to the All Systems results.

Breeze respondents were most likely to indicate that there were either “three” (21.3%), “four” (20.7%), or “two” (18.0%) people in their household, including themselves. Breeze results are significantly lower for “two” than All Systems results (24.5%).

Benicia Breeze respondents were most likely to indicate that their gross annual household income was under \$15,000 (22.0%), \$15,000 to \$24,999 (22.0%), or \$25,000 to \$49,999 (18.7%). Breeze results for under \$15,000 and \$15,000 to \$24,999 are significantly higher than those returned for All Systems (14.0% and 12.7%).
