

## How To Use This Guide

The map on the reserve side of this guide shows the Dial-A-Ride zone and the

intercity routes to Fairfield, Suisun City, Isleton, Pittsburg/Bay Point BART Station and Antioch with connections to Lodi. When using Route 51, call at least 15 minutes in advance for pick up from locations within Rio Vista, Isleton, Delta Loop Recreation Area, Oxbow Marina or resort communities along State Route 160 between Isleton and the Antioch Bridge.

All intercity bus stops are shown as black dots on the map. Timepoints (those highlighted on the schedule) are shown with white dots on the map. Use these easy steps to plan your trips:

- **I**) Use the map to identify the route(s) that connects where you are and where you wish to go.
- **2)** Find the nearest timepoint on the route which is nearest to the bus stop where you wish to board or call (707) 374-2878 to request the bus to come to your door, at least 30 minutes in advance before the bus arrives the timepoint closest to your pick up location.
- 3) Find the schedule for your route (it is shown in a matching color).
- 4) Find the timepoint on the schedule. Read down to see what time the bus departs from that point.
- 5) If you are boarding at a non-timepoint location or at a location off route, use the nearest timepoint before you stop to estimate the bus departure time.


\* This fare is valid for one pick up on Route 51. Each pick up requires full fare to be paid. This fare is also valid for service to Delta Loop communities and resort communities along State Route 160 between Isleton and the Antioch Bridge.

Up to two children under 5 ride free with a fare-paying passenger age 16 years old or older. Personal care attendants (PCA) may ride free with an passenger who has a disability as defined in the Americans With Disabilities Act.

Bay Area Regional Transit Connection Discount Cards (RTC) and Medicare Cards with photo ID are accepted for senior and persons with disabilities fares. For more information to obtain an RTC card call Rio Vista Delta Breeze at (707) 374-2878.



**Service Hours:** Rio Vista Delta Breeze operates



Transfers: Transfers between Rio Vista Delta Breeze routes are free and valid for one-way travel and must be redeemed on the next available bus.

Rio Vista Delta Breeze accepts transfers from Tri Delta Transit, The County Connection, SCT/LINK, Fairfield And Suisun Transit, Vallejo Transit, Amtrak California and Capitol Corridor. Rio Vista Delta Breeze also accepts BART Plus as a local fare credit. The above-mentioned agencies also accept Rio Vista Delta Breeze transfers at shared bus stops locations in their respective areas.

Greyhound and Amtrak Tickets: Rio Vista Delta Breeze accepts Greyhound and Amtrak tickets for travel along Route 50 and 52 when boarding at a location where Rio Vista Delta Breeze and Greyhound or Amtrak meet. No additional fare is required.

Route 50 meets Greyhound and Capitol Corridor at the Suisun/Fairfield Amtrak Station. Route 52 meets Amtrak California, through a deviation request, to the Amtrak Station in Antioch. SCT/LINK meets Greyhound and Amtrak California at the Lodi Station.

#### **Route Deviations and Dial-A-Ride**

**Information:** Call us to make a reservation, Monday-Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. When the dispatcher is unavailable after hours and weekends, please leave a message. Call at least 15 to 30 minutes in advance for a ride. Should you no longer need a ride. please cancel as soon as possible. The bus operates on a 30-minute window, expect the bus to show up at least 15 minutes before or 15 minutes after the time requested. The bus will only wait 5 minutes before proceeding to the next pick up or drop off. Rio Vista Delta Breeze is a **door-to-door** service. This means bus operators will provide assistance to the door of the pick up or drop off location with permission from the passenger. When making a reservation, please provide us with the following:

- Your name and telephone number
- ou would like to picked up
- you are going
- you need to arrive at your destination
- ou would like to return
- cial needs or requests

Route deviations on Routes 50 and 52 are on a first come, first served, space available basis. A passenger may only request up to 2 deviations, unless passengers loads are light to warrant more deviations. This means one deviation in the Rio Vista/Isleton area and one deviation in the outlying city that the route is serving. Each deviation is 50 cents and is paid on top of the intercity fare. ADA passengers receive free route deviations on Route 50 only.

Route 51 does not charge a route deviation fare. Every time a passenger gets off the bus, the passenger will need to pay the full fare to reboard Route 51 for travel to another destination served by Route 51.

#### Subscription service:

Available to passengers that have a regular travel pattern that is daily, weekly or monthly. Please call us to sign up for the service. The no-show and late cancel

policy applies to this service.

No Shows and Late Cancels: Prevent No Shows and Late Cancels! Please contact the dispatcher at (707) 374-2878 if you no longer a route deviation or trip on Route 51. If a passenger receives six no-shows and/or late cancels in a one-year period, they will be subject to a two-week suspension from riding Rio Vista Delta Breeze transit services. Passengers suspended may appeal the decision of the Transit Coordinator by mailing, faxing or emailing a letter to the Transit Coordinator. Contact information is on the Welcome Aboard panel.

**Package Policy:** Space is limited; please bring up to five bags and/or packages. Bus operators are allowed to

assist only to the door of the pick up or drop off packages that exceed 10 pounds.

Lost and Found: Should you lose an item on board a Rio Vista Delta Breeze bus, please call us. Items are held for up to 30 days before being donated to a local charity. The City and its contractors are not responsible for lost or stolen items. If you lose an item on Vista Cab, please call (707) 374-6572.

Ride and Read: River News Herald and Isleton Journal are sold on board all Rio Vista Delta Breeze buses each Wednesday for 50 cents.

Safe Place: Rio Vista Delta Breeze buses are "Safe Places". If you are between the ages 12 to 17 years old and you in danger, please board a Rio Vista Delta Breeze bus and ask the bus operator that you need a Safe Place. Our bus operators will help you obtain assistance from the Northern California Family Center. For more information call 1-925-370-1990 or visit www.ncfc.us.

**Mobility Training:** We can teach you how to ride the bus. You will learn how to read a bus schedule, board at a bus stop and utilize features that are on board a bus. Participants will receive a free 10-Ride InterCityPass through participating in this program. Call (707) 374-5337 for more details.

**ADA Service:** Passengers that are unable to board a fixed route bus or access a fixed route bus stop may apply for certification to use ADA service. ADA certified riders receive free deviations on Route 50 and coordinated transfers to Vallejo Runabout, DART and Tri-Delta Transit Dial-A-Ride for travel beyond Rio Vista, Fairfield, Suisun City or Antioch. Please call (707) 374-5337 for more details.

## How to Ride the Bus

I) Call for the Bus to Come to You: Route 51 passengers traveling in the Rio Vista, Isleton area or from the Delta Loop Recreation Area, Oxbow Marina and resort communities on State Route 160 between Isleton and the Antioch Bridge may call at least 15 minutes in advance, the same day up to 7 days in advance.

Routes 50 and 52 passengers may call at least 30 minutes in advance, the same day, up to 7 days in advance to have the bus come to you within Rio Vista, Isleton, Lodi, Antioch, Fairfield and Suisun City on a first come, first served, space available basis. Each passenger is limited to 2 deviations unless space permits additional deviations.

### 2) Flag the Bus

You can catch the bus anywhere along its route or service area by flagging the bus down as it drives by Pick a safe, visible location and wave your arm as the bus approaches. To ensure that you are not missed, please call us and let us know when and where you will be waiting. To get off the bus between designated stops, just ask the bus operator.



Bicycles are allowed on board all Rio Vista Delta Breeze buses. Two bicycles can be stored on the front rack. If the rack is full, the bicycle may be brought inside in the bus at the bus operator's discretion. Riders are



responsible for loading and unloading their own bicycles. The City or its contractors are not responsible for lost, stolen or damage bicycles.

All buses are equipped with passenger lifts for mobility devices and meets the ADA requirements. Lifts can only accommodate passengers and mobility devices that do not exceed 600 pounds combined or the size of a standard wheelchair.

## **Rules of the Road**

Rules ensure the safety and comfort for all passengers and the bus operator. Please observe the following rules:



- No smoking on buses or transit facilities.
- Eating and drinking are permitted provided that you dispose of your waste from eating or drinking and do not spill on board the bus.
- No standing in front of the white "standee" line while the bus is in motion.
- No unnecessary conversation with the bus operator.
- No abusive, threatening or obscene language on the
- All electronic devices turned on require the use of headphones.
- No hazardous materials or weapons of any kind shall be allowed on board (except oxygen)
- All animals brought on board must be in an approved carrier, except properly documented service animals.
- No signs or advertisements may be placed on board vehicles. Contact City Bus Advertising at (707) 544-2115 or email bobstowe@sonic.net to advertise on board buses.
- No vandalism or graffiti is allowed on buses or transit facilities.
- No illegal activity of any kind shall be tolerated.
- All strollers, scooters, folding carts and large packages must be stowed under the passenger seat.
- Rollerblades and skates are not allowed to be worn on buses.
- Shoes and shirts are required to ride buses.
- No littering on buses or transit facilities.

The above rules are enforced under the California Penal Code Section 640. Violation of the rules may result in the suspension of ride, a \$250 fine and/or six months of community service.


